An environmental justice documentary exploring indigenous peoples' right to water, the environmental impacts of mining, and the lack of protection for sacred sites by the federal government.

Echo Maker shares the voices of the Anishinaabe peoples from the shores of Lake Superior and the surrounding Keweenaw Bay Indian Community, and brings to light the stark contrast of viewpoint between people and industry, not only in treatment of land and water, but also prioritization of resources and consideration of long term impacts upon future generations.
